Signing of agreement between FISH and Mandurah Primary School.
- 2:25 Placing of feet by student council and classroom representatives at flag pole
- 2:30 Close of ceremony. Classes to move to designated area in under cover area for afternoon tea.
- 2:50 Afternoon tea (kangaroo sausages, meatballs and damper) inclusive of traditional face painting of community members
- 2:55 Students and Teachers return to classrooms for end of day release.
