

## How will we use your information?

The survey and request for organisational submissions and case studies is published and managed by The Healing Foundation. The results and information shared will be analysed and used by The Healing Foundation to develop the Queensland Healing Strategy and inform collaboration with the Queensland Government to implement the strategy.

A report on all information received during the co-design process will be prepared by The Healing Foundation. The report will be available to the public and will be provided to the Queensland Government. The Healing Foundation will do its best to represent the issues and ideas that you have raised.

Access to raw data from the survey, submissions and case studies is limited to The Healing Foundation. You have the option to choose if your comments and responses can be attributed to you and / or your organisation. If you do not wish to have your input attributed to you, only The Healing Foundation will have this information.

## **Creative input**

Art, music and other forms of creative expression are cultural ways that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people communicate and convey knowledge about events, beliefs and to teach future generations. Sometimes our creative expressions and the stories behind them say more than can be expressed in a standard survey.
